M&S Car Park - IMPORTANT NOTICE - we have been informed by M&S that the new ANPR carpark monitoring system installed in their Chepstow carpark will be in full operation from Monday 12th November 2018. The system will be in operation 24 hours a day, 7 days a week. The only concession they are willing to give us is that we will have **FREE parking on Sunday mornings for worship services, until 1pm.** At all other times the conditions as described on the carpark notice boards will apply. Briefly, that is, **the cost, £1.00 for 2 hours parking (unless your stay is less than 15 minutes, in which case, it is free): Maximum stay 2 hours: no return within 2 hours.** Exceeding these, or failure to purchase a ticket, where required, will result in a fine of £85!
