M&S PARKING FOR CHRISTMAS EVE & CHRISTMAS DAY



A REMINDER ABOUT THE 'TUB2PUB' INITIATIVE

Tub2Pub is the initiative set up by Greene King pubs to ensure these plastic tubs don't go to waste; instead, they are collected from the pubs and taken to a plastic reprocessing centre where they are shredded, before being sold onto plastic manufacturers to use in place of virgin plastics.



All money raised from the sale of Tub2Pub plastics will be given directly to Macmillan Cancer Support (in early 2025 over **240,000 tubs** were collected raising £10,916 for the charity).

Greene King pubs, hotels and restaurants will be accepting clean and empty Confectionery, Biscuit and Cracker Tubs from 1st January -15th February 2026.

Russell & Hilary are willing to be a 'depository' for your tubs so just bring them along to church over the coming weeks.
