A Thanksgiving for Tony's life will take place in church **THIS Tuesday 24th February at 1.30pm.**



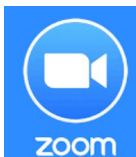
The family have asked that those attending wear bright, loud clothing.

BEACON CLOSURE

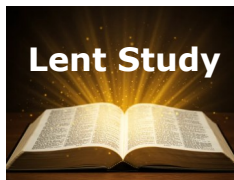
